

Sant Feliu de Pallerols is a Catalan town in the province of Girona, located in the county of La Garrotxa, at the head of the Hostoles Valley. The entire municipality forms part of the La Garrotxa Volcanic Zone Natural Park, and part of its southern area lies within the Collsacabra Natural Area of Interest. Three main features define the town of Sant Feliu de Pallerols:

THE LANDSCAPE, surrounded by mountains and volcanoes. Water is ever-present: the Brugent River crosses the town, and numerous springs emerge from its soil. A varied landscape, ideal for hiking.

CULTURE AND TRADITION, a town of important musicians and outstanding artists. With a thousand-year-old tradition: the Dance of the Little Horses, Giants and Mulassa, which, together with the Festa Major, has been declared a Heritage Festival of National Interest by the Government of Catalonia. And with a legend that gives the town its identity, as the people of Sant Feliu are widely known as the "pescallunes".

HISTORY, the town preserves the elements that bear witness to its eventful past: Romanesque bridges and churches, medieval castles such as Hostoles and Collort, ancestral homes and the old town centre. It is also remença territory, as the remença revolts -the uprising of the peasants against the feudal lords- left their mark here. Sant Feliu de Pallerols is a town that surprises you and, in the end, catches you!

HISTORY OF THE REMENÇA PEASANTS OF THE HOSTOLES VALLEY

Today, the struggle of the Catalan remença peasants is considered the first organised revolt of European peasants to achieve a positive final outcome: the abolition of servitudes. In this sense, the Arbitral Award of Guadalupe is the first institutional document granted in Europe concerning the liberation of serfs.

Francesc de Verntallat — peasant, captain general, friend and adviser to kings, great strategist and organiser — was the key figure in ensuring that the remença conflict reached a favourable final resolution. He was involved in all the crucial moments of the peasant movement: its leadership at the beginning of 1462, the victory of the first revolt, the defence of the Mountain between the two wars, the resistance after Sala's revolt and, finally, the commitment of the peasants who accepted royal
